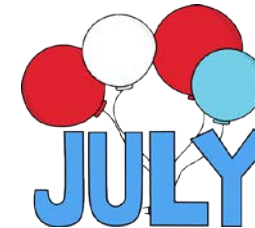

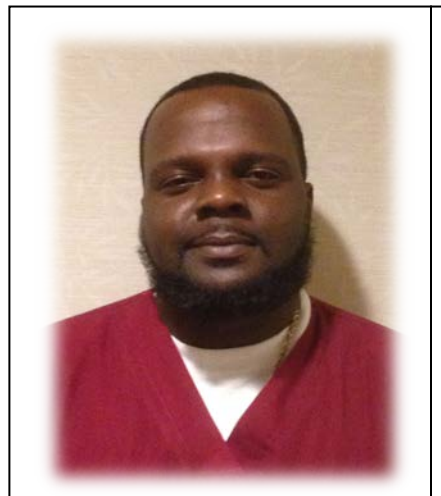


**Maxine Winstel**
